

EAST ASIAN STUDIES MAJOR

This is a list of the current requirements for the East Asian Studies major. Any students who are interested in this field as a major should come to the office for advising. You may particularly want to consider the possibility of a double major. Also, Study Abroad in Japan, Taiwan, or China may fulfill many of the East Asian requirements.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MAJOR

30 credits

ADDITIONAL COURSES

Select 3 credits beyond the 12-credits of proficiency in an East Asian Language:

CHNS 110, JAPNS 110, or the equivalent

Select 9 credits with 3 credits from each of the categories a, b, and c:

- a. HIST 174 or HIST 175
- b. RL ST 003, 104 or 181
- c. CMLIT 004 or PHIL 111

SUPPORTING COURSES AND RELATED AREAS

Select 18 credits from the following, at least 12 credits of which are to be at the 400 level; additional further credits in language studies may be permitted up to 6 credits:
